Wellington House is in Wellington Street next to Elm Grove Primary School.

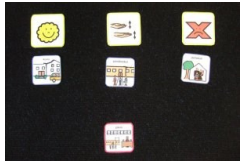

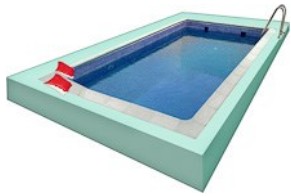
