**Brighton & Hove Various Controlled Parking Zones Consolidation Order 2024
Amendment Order No.* 202* (ref: TRO-10-2026)**

STATEMENT OF REASONS

The Council's reasons for proposing the following orders are set out below: -

To facilitate the placement of communal on-street waste and recycling bins for residents living in flats above nearby commercial premises. At present, individual wheelie bins are kept on the pavement, creating a cluttered and obstructive arrangement along the pavement.

Designated areas on the public highway are required to ensure that communal on-street bins can be sited in locations that are safely accessible to residents while avoiding obstruction to pedestrians, cyclists, and other road users. The allocated areas will prevent the bins from being moved into parking bays, placed in positions that interfere with vehicle movements, or relocated for the purposes of securing parking spaces.

The Order is therefore considered necessary:

(a) for avoiding danger to persons or other traffic using the road to which the order relates or any other road, by ensuring that communal on-street bins are positioned safely and do not create hazards or impede visibility, movement, or access on the highway.
