Terms & Conditions of Use

- 1) A Leisure Card is available to anyone whose normal residential home is within the boundaries of Brighton & Hove and is in receipt of any of the above benefits listed on the application form.
- 2) Leisure Card holders who are parents or guardians of dependant children (aged 16 or under) may apply for each child to have their own Leisure Card.
- 3) Applicants must show proof that they are in receipt of a benefit listed overleaf by presenting the original benefit award letter or a bank statement showing where the benefit is paid into. This proof needs to be dated within the last 12 months. Failure to do this will mean that a Leisure Card will not be issued.
- 4) Applicants must show proof of identifications including any dependant children listed on the application form. Acceptable forms of identification includes UK Passport, Driving Licence, National Insurance Card, NHS Medical Card or Birth Certificate.
- 5) The Leisure Card is free of charge and must be presented every time the card holder wants to claim the relevant discount. Failure to do so will mean that the full price will be charged.
- 6) A charge of £2.00 will be made per replacement card.
- 7) The Leisure Card will be valid for 6 months from date of issue. Applicants will renew their card after this date with proof of benefit as detailed in point 3 above.
- 8) The activities covered by the Leisure Card are subject to availability and may change or be withdrawn without notice at anytime.
- 9) The Leisure Card can only be used by the person detailed on the application form.
- 10) If the status of a Leisure Card holder changes they must inform Freedom Leisure immediately.
- 11) The activities available at a discount depend on the centre that you use. Full details can be obtained from each centre.
- 12) The information on the application form may be used at anytime to check the validity of the information provided with Brighton & Hove City Council Revenue and Benefits department.
- 13) The Leisure Card holder must abide by the centre rules. Full details can be obtained from each centre.
- 14) Freedom Leisure may expel you from a centre and/or end your status as a Leisure Card holder without notice at any time if:
 - 14.1) You break the conditions of the Leisure Card agreement.
 - 14.2) You do not apply with the rules and regulations of each centre.
 - 14.3) You allow another person to use your Leisure Card.
