- 1) A Leisure Card is available to anyone whose normal residential home is within the boundaries of Brighton & Hove and is in receipt of any of the above benefits listed on the application form.
- 2) Leisure Card holders who are parents or guardians of dependant children (aged 16 or under) may apply for each child to have their own Leisure Card.
- 3) Applicants must show proof that they are in receipt of a benefit listed overleaf by presenting the original benefit award letter or a bank statement showing where the benefit is paid into. This proof needs to be dated within the last 12 months. Failure to do this will mean that a Leisure Card will be not be issued.
- 4) Applicants must show proof of identifications including any dependant children listed on the application form. Acceptable forms of identification includes UK Passport, Driving Licence, National Insurance Card, NHS Medical Card or Birth Certificate.
- 5) The Leisure Card is free of charge and must be presented every time the card holder wants to claim the relevant discount. Failure to do so will mean that the full price will be charged.
- 6) A charge of £2.00 will be made per replacement card.
