
## GUIDE TO PHOTOGRAPHS FOR PERSONAL LICENCE APPLICATIONS

## What is being certified?

On signing one of your two photographs, the counter-signatory is declaring that the photograph is a true likeness of yourself.

Below is an example of a correctly signed photograph.



## Who can countersign my photographs for application?

- THE COUNTER-SIGNATORY MUST HOLD A PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATION.
- THE COUNTER-SIGNATORY MAY NOT BE A SPOUSE OR RELATIVE.
- LICENSEES MAY NOT CERTIFY PHOTOS.

Please note, that although the NLC is classed as a professional qualification, licensees are not acceptable counter-signatories.
