A Child Pedestrian Training Course has been booked at your child's school. This leaflet has been designed to outline the benefits of the training, and acquire your consent for your child to take part. Please fill in the consent form and return it to your child's school as soon as possible.

The Training

The number of child pedestrian fatalities in the United Kingdom is high compared to other European countries. Children aged between 11 and 15 remain the most at risk.

Child Pedestrian Training is one of the initiatives that can help reduce the number of child casualties of all severity. Starting to learn pedestrian safety early and by the roadside means that they can establish these skills before they become independent travellers.

The training consists of practical roadside and classroom activities, taught in schools during school time. Children work with fully trained, police checked Child Pedestrian Trainers in small groups (maximum of three pupils per adult). Risk assessed sites are used, and all participants wear fluorescent tabards.



The training is taught in two stages.

Stage 1

(Year One, 5 - 6 years old)

During this stage children learn about different vehicles and dangers in car parks. They investigate the road environment and discuss where traffic could come from and go to, and consider safer places to cross the road using the Green Cross Code.

Stage 2

(Year Three, 7 - 8 years old)

During this stage, children are taught how to cross safely near to parked cars and junctions, if there is no other safer place to cross.

The completion of this training does not mean that your child is able to walk by the road unaccompanied. The children are being trained for future independent travel.
